These juried fine art/fine craft fairs are held outdoors on the Figge Art Museum Plaza and on 2nd Street in downtown Davenport, Iowa rain or shine.

The Beaux Arts Fund Committee, a non-profit group of volunteers, donates proceeds to the Figge Art Museum to help fund exhibitions and educational programs. No commissions will be charged. The fairs are free to the public.

Location:

Figge Art Museum Plaza, 225 W. 2nd Street, and continuing on 2nd Street between Harrison & Ripley Streets, Davenport, Iowa

Hours for both fairs:

Saturday 10:00 am to 5:00 pm
 Sunday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm

Security:

Artists may leave display overnight Friday and Saturday at their own risk. Security will be provided beginning at 5 pm Friday, however, damage or loss will be the responsibility of the artist and not the Fair Committee. Police and EMS will be present throughout the entire event.

Cancellation Policy:

All cancellations must be made in writing, signed by the artist, and postmarked on or before April 2, 2010 for Spring fair or August 6, 2010 for Fall fair. Any accepted artist who cancels and meets above requirements will be entitled to a refund less a \$50 processing fee. Absolutely no refunds will be made for cancellations postmarked after April 2 (Spring fair) or August 6 (Fall fair).

Artist's Breakfast on Sunday morning:

We invite you to join us for the Artist's Breakfast. Each artist and a guest are invited to join us. (Two complimentary meals available per application.) Fill out meal box on the application form if you wish to attend. Additional meals can be purchased. Location details will be in your acceptance letter.

How to Enter:

Jury Process.

Please submit three slides or CD (jpeg. format) of work done in the last 3 years, and one of booth. Label each slide or face of CD clearly with artist's name. Label each image/slide with applicable number 1-4, title, & size of work to coordinate with application. Artist's name or person should not appear within images on slides, jpegs or jpeg labels. Slides should be in plastic sleeves. No photos please.

Each artist is required to submit a non-refundable \$10.00 jury fee. Separate checks are required for jury fee, booth fee/additional meals and corner fee. Completed application and all checks must be received in advance of the jurying process. If not accepted, all checks will be returned except the non-refundable jury fee.

Save \$10.00

Jury once per calendar year and pay one jury fee. Applicants applying for both fairs at the same time only need to pay one jury fee. **Also, only one set of slides or images need to be submitted if you apply for both fairs in the Spring.** This means that your images/slides will be held over for the Fall Fair jury. Acceptance or rejection to the Spring Fair does not affect acceptance or rejection to the Fall Fair. Each fair will be juried separately. All checks and both spring & fall completed applications must be submitted for both fairs by Feb. 15 to qualify. Booth/meal and corner checks will not be cashed until their respective notification dates.

Rules:

- All Artists & Craftsmen over the age of 18, professional or amateur are invited to exhibit and sell their work.
- All work must be of original design and handcrafted by the exhibiting artist.
- Process for making artwork must be fully explained on application and will be read to jury. No other information will be read such as awards, etc. except title, size and price.
- One medium/one artist per booth/no shared booths.
- All exhibitors must provide their own display, tables, chairs, and white canopy. All storage must be contained and concealed within booth area.
- All booths will be on pavement with **NO staking or drilling permitted.** Structures should be built to withstand gusty winds. Sandbags and/or other appropriate equipment is required to ensure the stability of displays. Any artist with a hazardous display will be required to close and will forfeit their registration fee.
- **No gas powered generators allowed.**
- Exhibitors are required to collect and submit IA state sales tax. Temporary tax forms will be available.
- Beaux Arts Committee has the authority to request the removal of any exhibit or undesirable items.
- Booth must remain open during fair hours.

Set-Up:

PLAZA: Setup times will be assigned for the plaza area only, beginning at noon on Friday. Detailed instructions will be mailed with acceptance letter. Arriving during your set up time will assure you the most convenient access to your booth. Please note that the plaza has a slope of 3" in 10'.

STREET: You may start setting up on the street after 3 pm on Friday.

COME PREPARED TO CART!

Vehicles must be out of the Fair area by 9am on Fair day, no exceptions!

Teardown:

Teardown is not permitted until close of art fair! NO vehicles will be allowed on fair grounds until Security deems that it is safe to do so! NO EXCEPTIONS! Failure to abide will result in future non-participation. Teardown instructions will be included in your packet at check-in.
